Job Summary:

As a sports coach, the primary responsibility is to provide expert training for athletes in Grades 5 through 8. Athletic Coaches use their skills in the development of the student, and ensure that peak performance and fitness are achieved during crucial times, such as competitions, tournaments, matches, trials and qualifying events. The position reports to the Director of Athletics.

Responsibilities:

1. Serve as a liaison for the Athletic Department
2. Establish the fundamental philosophy, skills and techniques to be taught to the student-athletes.
3. Provides proper safeguards for assigned equipment
4. Provides assistance, guidance and safeguards for each participant by his/her presence at all practices, games, while traveling and when returning from off-campus events.
